1. **BETRAYED BY FRIEND – Psalms 41:9(NIV)** ⁹Even my close friend, whom I trusted, he who shared my bread, has lifted up his heel against me.
2. **FORSAKEN BY DISCIPLES – Psalms 31:11(NIV)**
¹¹Because of all my enemies, I am the utter contempt of my neighbors; I am a dread to my friends— those who see me on the street flee from me.
3. **FALSE ACCUSATION – Psalms 35:11(NIV)** ¹¹Ruthless witnesses come forward; they question me on things I know nothing about.
4. **SILENCE BEFORE JUDGES - Isaiah 53:7(NIV)** ⁷He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth.
5. **PROVEN WITHOUT GUILT - Isaiah 53:9(NIV)** ⁹He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth.
6. **NUMBERED WITH TRANSGRESSORS – Isaiah 53:12(NIV)** ¹²Therefore I will give him a portion among the great,^o and he will divide the spoils with the strong,^o because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.
7. **CRUCIFIED - Psalms 22:16(NIV)** ¹⁶Dogs have surrounded me; a band of evil men has encircled me, they have pierced^o my hands and my feet.
8. **MOCKED - Psalms 109:25(NIV)** ²⁵I am an object of scorn to my accusers; when they see me, they shake their heads.
9. **GARMENTS GAMBLED FOR - Psalms 22:18(NIV)** ¹⁸They divide my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing.
10. **PRAYED FOR ENEMIES Isaiah 53:12(NIV)** ¹²Therefore I will give him a portion among the great,^o and he will divide the spoils with the strong,^o because he poured out his life unto

death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

11. **FORSAKEN BY FATHER – Psalms 22:1(NIV)** ¹My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, so far from the words of my groaning?
12. **COMMITTED HIS SPIRIT – Psalms 31:5(NIV)** ⁵Into your hands I commit my spirit; redeem me, O LORD, the God of truth.
13. **NOT ONE BONE BROKEN – Psalms 34:20(NIV)** ²⁰he protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.
14. **BURIED IN BORROWED TOMB - Isaiah 53:9(NIV)** ⁹He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth.
